Scholarship Application Requirements

- Currently be a senior attending a public, private or parochial high school located in Bell or Coryell County
- Complete Scholarship Application
- Provide two letters of recommendation. Letters of recommendation should not be from a family member.
 - 1. One letter of recommendation from a *High School* scholastic staff or faculty member (Principal, Assistant Principal, Counselor, Teacher, etc.)
 - 2. One letter of recommendation from a community member (Minister, Employer, etc.)
- An official high school transcript. The transcript should be stamped, sealed or signed by your school's registrar.
- Provide signed documentation of community service hours. Documentation should include location, date, description of service, amount of service time and signature of adult sponsor





- Write an essay.
 - 1. The essay must be 500-750 words, typed, double spaced, 12-point font and Times New Roman font face.
 - 2. Essay cover sheet should include your name, name your high school and essay topic
- Essay Topics please select one
 - 1. "It is very important to know who you are. To make decisions. To show who you are." Malala Yousafzai. Tell us three things that are important to you. How did you arrive at this list?
 - 2. "The secret of our success is that we never, never give up." Wilma Mankiller. Tell us about a time when you failed at something. What were the circumstances? How did you respond to failure? What lessons did you learn?
 - 3. Do you believe that standardized testing has helped or hindered student learning?
 - 4. "Education is the most powerful weapon which you can use to change the world." Nelson Mandela. Describe a change you would like to make in the world. Tell us about how you would plan to make that change, and what obstacles you might encounter along the way.
 - 5. What social justice issue is important to you? Why are you personally motivated to examine this issue in greater depth? Describe a time when you engaged others in meaningful dialogue around this issue that was important to you. Did this exchange create change, new perspectives, or deeper relationships?
- Application packets must be **<u>post-marked</u>** by March 20, 2023. Packets **<u>post-marked</u>** after this date will be returned.
